



Advisory Board Policy

General information

To promote long term sustainability and ensure that experience and know-how in the association is exchanged and prolonged, UF may recruit Advisors. The general purpose of the board is to be available for non-binding advice and knowledge exchange. The purpose of the advisors is *not* to act as unofficial members of the UF Board.

As an Advisor,

Appointment of Advisors

Advisors are appointed through a decision at a board meeting. The board may not consist of more than eight (8) advisors. The recruitment of an advisor is based on the needs of the association.

Term

Advisors may act as such for as long as the association deems it necessary. Advisors can also be appointed for a fixed term. An advisor may abdicate their position at any time by informing the President in writing.
