



## Policy for Travel Subsidies

### General

To make UF travels more available, expenses for members of the Travel Group may be subsidised to the extent that the board finds appropriate. Expenses for Travel Coordinator and Travel Assistant may also be subsidised to a greater extent to make the positions possible for applications from people from all backgrounds. A decision to subsidise travel expenses requires a decision from the board.

In order to make UF travels more environmental friendly, a decision of climate compensation for flights may be taken, given that the board finds it appropriate. This should not be seen as a way to neglect further climate friendly decisions (such as alternative transportation to flying or choosing direct flights instead of layover flights), but rather serve as a small climate contribution. A decision to climate compensate travels requires a decision from the board.

### Definition of travel expenses

Travel expenses include cost for transport and lodging. Other expenses, such as cost for food and other living costs may not be subsidised.

### Considerations

The decision should be made after considering the associations economic situation at the time of the decision and in accordance with our Policy for Economy and Long-term Savings.
