



Motion regarding the change of title for Web Editor and Vice Web Editor

Background

The question regarding the revision of the titles *web editor* (*webbredaktör*) and *vice web editor* (*vice webbredaktör*) has been discussed before. The titles currently in use by the editors in the editorial team may seem inconsistent and cause confusion among Uttryck Magazine's writers and other active members. The new titles for the positions in the web magazine should therefore be the same as the printed magazine. There would then be one web editor-in-chief and one web editor. The new titles are proposed to be *web editor-in-chief* (*chefswebbredaktör*) and *web editor* (*webbredaktör*).

Purpose

The purpose of the motion is to clarify the task assignments and roles between the different positions in the editorial team. By changing the title from web editor to web editor-in-chief there would clearly be three editors-in-chief in charge of the work of the magazine. At the same time, by changing the title from vice web editor to web editor, it clarifies that that role is equal to the other editors and is not necessarily second in command to the web editor-in-chief.

Pleading

May the board decide:

To accept the changing of the titles from web editor/*webbredaktör* and vice web editor/*vice webbredaktör* to *web editor-in-chief/chefswebbredaktör* and *web editor/webbredaktör*?
