



Motion to approve advisory board member

Background

The advisory board gathers a combination of individuals which with their previous engagement in UF Uppsala has a deep knowledge about its organizational structure and history, and those with less experience from UF Uppsala but with a career path which can be beneficial for the board in terms of assistance. Their task is to every semester have a meeting with the President and Vice President to discuss the coming priorities and challenges and to continuously throughout the year be available to provide guidance. A more detailed description of the advisory board's structure, priorities and tasks can be found in the policy itself.

I have asked Niclas Hvalgren if he would be interested in become a member of the advisory board, and he has accepted the nomination. Here follows a motivation:

Niclas has a long history in UF Uppsala and the general UF sphere. He became active in UF Uppsala in 2015 and was elected to the position of program secretary (today called head of lectures) in 2016. He was in 2017 given the mandate by the members of UF Uppsala to become the association's president. In 2018 he became the treasurer for the Swedish Association of International Affairs. During UF Uppsala's operational year of 2019/2020, Niclas served as the association's auditor.

Niclas received his bachelor in economics from Uppsala University and is currently pursuing a master degree in economics from the Stockholm School of Economics. His academic focus, in combination with his experiences from being an auditor and treasurer for the national association, makes him well suited to provide economic guidance to UF Uppsala. His long experience from UF related organisations will also let him provide organisational perspectives on issues facing UF Uppsala in the coming years.
