Proposals

to appoint Aminata Touray as Career Group Trustee for the operational year of 2020/2021.

Pros and Cons

Because of COVID-19, last operational years' UF career fair ("Career Day 2020") was postponed. The new date (for the now virtually held fair) is set on November 9th, with a project deadline early October for the virtual fair arrangers to receive all relevant data for their work. This means the Career Group has a deadline coming up in three weeks and is in desperate need of a labour force. A candidate has been interviewed and put forward by the Heads of Careers (as written in the appendix). After careful inspection of UF bylaws and policies (as well as verification & validation from President Isak Lefvert & Vice President Stella Xing) we find this appointment to be both in accordance with the bylaws and motivated regarding policy by the situation at hand.

Not appointing this trustee could have devastating consequences, both for the Career Group and for UF Uppsala, which could manifest in a loss of trust from the organisations attending, partner associations, as well as a waste of significant money, and a lot of work from as far back as 2019.

An appointment will mean avoiding such consequences, as well as some much-needed ease of burden for everyone involved. This ease of burden would, amongst other things, mean that the Heads of Careers can start planning/executing other projects for the benefit of both the Career Group and UF Uppsala.

Decision
